The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 3:04 PM on October 22, 2024 in the Supervisor's meeting room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgement of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. D/PA Mike Boden and Dennis Maggert gave their proposal on self-funded plan using Blue Cross Blue Shield as the health provider. Boden recommend that the county stay on a self-funded plan and not move to a fully insured plan.
- 8.2. Kipp Kissinger, UNICO: discuss proposed Employee Benefit Plans for Washington County. D/PA Kissinger passed out a proposal and gave a recommendation to have the county move from Pareto Captive to a traditional market through QBE with a \$50,000 specific deductible. Board member Kramer also provided a comparison summary sheet giving the differences between proposals from NACO and UNICO. Board discussed at length and asked for more time to review the plans. Both UNICO and NACO stated that a decision would need to be made prior to the next regular board meeting to get open enrollment prepared in a timely manner.

Whereas: The State of Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) requires that each county must annually certify (by December 31st of each year) the appointment(s) of the County Highway Superintendent(s) to the DNOT using the Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent from; and

Whereas: The NDOT requires that such certification shall also include a copy of the documentation of the county highway superintendent's appointment, i.e, meeting minutes showing the appointment of the Count Highway Superintendent by their name as it appears on their License (if applicable), their License Number (if applicable) and Class of License (if applicable), the type of appointment, i.e., employed or under contract (consultant, or interlocal agreement with another county and/or incorporated municipality), and the beginning date of the appointment; and

Whereas: The NDOT also requires that such Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent form shall be signed by the County Board Chairperson and shall include a copy of a resolution of the County Board authorizing the signing of the Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent form by the County Board Chairperson.
